The Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District will be holding the third of three public workshops regarding the proposal to remove hazardous trees at three locations along San Leandro Creek (see attached map). The first and second workshops (that took place on June 22 and 29) addressed hazard trees at the end Huff Avenue and Cary Drive.

The **third** workshop is focused on the area at the end of St. Mary Avenue, and is intended to seek input from area residents on approaches to address tree hazards on District properties in San Leandro Creek. This third workshop will be held as follows:
